West Lincoln Kin Club Folding

After 35 years of Serving the Community's greatest need, the Kin Club of West Lincoln has decided to fold as of July 1, 2013.

Kin has been a mainstay in West Lincoln since the Kinsmen Club was chartered on May 26, 1978. A year later in 1979, the association welcomed the West Lincoln Kinettes.

The clubs fundraised for the local library, hockey teams, Community Care, and for the West Lincoln Hospital. Every year they would also raise money by hosting a skateathon with the support of the three elementary schools. The students would receive pledges and then skate around the ice for a specified period of time. All money raised was invested back to the community with a portion going to Cystic Fibrosis. The top 3 students that raised money also won prizes courtesy of the Kinsmen and Kinette clubs. For the Secondary students, the club provided a bursary to

the top student who volunteered and supported the community.

After 16 years and declining membership, the clubs decided to amalgamate and form as a Kin Club in September 1994. Over the last 19 years the club continued to support the community by supporting the Santa Clause parade, Road Tolls for Cystic Fibrosis, and countless nights of Euchre. Who could forget the numerous raffles, dances, and fertilizer drives too.

Thank you to President Bob Dell, Vice President Arie Kleinendorst, Treasurer Tom McLachlan and Secretary Joanne McLachlan for keeping the Kin spirit alive for being a club of just 4 members these last few years.

On behalf of all the members and clubs in Zone D, thank you for everything you have done. Your club will not be forgotten, and you are all welcome to join or visit any of the clubs in Zone D. You will be missed!






