

2026 DISTRICT 1 PROPOSED RESOLUTIONS

RESOLUTION 1: WORDING UPDATE, District CF/Service Director

Intent: To correct the title of District CF/Service Director(s) to District Service Director(s)

WHEREAS: Representing Cystic Fibrosis is only one small part of the role of a Service Director, and Cystic Fibrosis Canada has moved away from the CF short form; and

WHEREAS: All other Districts and National refer to the position as a District Service Director

Be it Proposed that: Article 5, Section 1, Part 3, Article 7, Section 5, Article 14 Section 6 and all other spots as needed be reworded to reflect this change: CF/Service Director to District Service Director.

RESOLUTION 2: WORDING UPDATE-ARTICLE 19, PUBLISHING OF HOUSE RULES

Intent: TO remove the requirement to mail or deliver the house rules to each club president annually, as the updated copy is found on the district 1 Website

WHEREAS: The District House rules are easily found in PDF Format on the District 1 Website, and can be printed from there; and

WHEREAS: Printing and mailing of the house rules is quite expensive. Being on the website makes them available to all members, not just the club presidents; and

WHEREAS: Without the requirement to print the house rules, the \$5 charge for printing the house rules can be removed from district dues next year.

Be it resolved that: Article 19, Section 1, Part 2 be revised from:

2. All amendments to these House Rules shall be published each year by the incoming District Executive and a complete copy of these House Rules shall be mailed or delivered to each incoming Club President.

2. All amendments to these House Rules shall be published each year by the incoming District Executive on the District 1 website, and a link to the appropriate webpage will be emailed to each club president.

RESOLUTION 3: WORDING UPDATE ARTICLE 7, Section 11-Absence or Resignation

Intent: To clarify directions for resignation or death of a Vice-Governor.

WHEREAS: The current house rules have a section for how to deal with the loss of a Governor, but nothing for the loss of an elected Vice-Governor

Be it resolved that: Article 7, Section 11 be revised to include:

In the event of the absence, resignation or death of a District Vice-Governor, the Vice Governor and Governors of the day shall meet and the remaining Vice-Governor will either select an appropriate replacement or decide whether they will move forward as a single leader.
