Scoring

Host zone team gets 100 points
Each zone team registered 50 points
Best performing zone team 25 points
2nd 15 points
3rd 10 points
25 points if you submit pictures

10 points if the event is on the D1 calendar. Examples of qualified Team events:

Lawn Bowling, Trivia Nights, Darts, Golf, Euchre, Cornhole Tournaments, Etc.

Events must be approved/registered with Governors to qualify for points.

HERES HOW IT WORKS:

1 team per zone made up of members of 75% of the clubs in their zone.

Each zone may put forth an event for teams to play (can be open to the public) examples of events are curling, trivia night, darts, lawn bowling, corn hole, golf, euchre.

zone teams scores are compared to each other.

Scoring

Host team receives 100 points

Each zone team registered 50 points

Best performing team (1st place) 25 points 2nd place 15 points 3rd place 10 points

10 points if the event is on the D1 website

10 points for teams submitting pictures to communication director.

*Events must be approved and registered by the Governors

In this sample 80% (75% required) of clubs represented on the team. If a dart tournament 4/team the team could send any 4 members on the team.
